



Job Title: Wrangler

Reports To: Camp Director, Volunteer Riding Director, APC Riding Manager, APC Wranglers

Purpose: To help campers learn to love and enjoy horses, teach them how to work with horses, how to ride, and use the horse program to be a reflection of the love of the Creator and the created.

Essential Job Responsibilities:

The wrangler is a position designed for those who enjoy working with horses, love children, and have a very strong work ethic.

Wrangler duties include but are not limited to:

- Feed and care for horses
- Periodically haul hay
- Tack and untack all horses
- Teach various horsemanship and riding skills to campers
- Supervise and guide camp trail rides
- Hold staff and campers accountable in policy enforcement
- Report any incidents according to the APC policies and guidelines
- Assist campers and staff in Horse program
- Demonstrate sensitivity to the needs of campers and Summer Staff
- Able to follow directions well
- Able to function in a fast-paced and hard-working environment

Qualifications:

- Must be a minimum of 18 years of age
- Must love kids and horses
- Must be willing to work hard and lift at least 50lbs
- Prior experience with horses is recommended, and experience working with children on horseback is preferred, but not required
